School District No. 20 or the Brock Mountain School was built around 1813 and was located on Cat Hollow Road near the intersection of Sugar Loaf Road which is presently Route 7 and School House Road.

School Flag Law:

"Each school district and city in state must supply a United States Flag, flag staff and other necessities for each school house of the state.

The flag should be displayed during school hours and at any other times as the school authority shall require.

Penalty for not complying with flag law: removal of trustees from office."
